
Cost Comparison With and Without Housemates

The goal of the housemate pairing process is to support existing relationships and natural supports whenever possible (e.g., family, friends, co-workers, neighbors, and acquaintances), or identify potential housemates with a survey tool, then discuss housemate preferences in a meet and greet to determine if selected housemate/s are a good fit.

Housemate Pairing Process

- Use Housemate Pairing Questions and Housemate Agreement
- Client supported to fill an empty bedroom in a unit with other housemates
- Use Housemate Pairing Questions and Housemate Agreement
 - •Client completes Housemate Pairing Survey, then meets with matched housemate to discuss housemate deal-breakers
 - Use Housemate Survey, Housemate Questions, Housemate Agreement

If the client does not have access to natural supports or existing relationships, most SH providers implement a basic two-step housemate pairing process:

- 1. Housemate Pairing Survey given to clients interested in Shared Housing
- 2. Potential Matches (made by staff) are invited to meet each other, one on one or in a small group, to determine dealbreakers, discuss accommodations and establish a written contract with each other with the Housemate Agreement.
